## **FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse**

Small but Wise Creatures, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Proverbs 30:24-28.

**\*Parent note:** In the Bible event the coney was changed to a beaver because most children know what a beaver is and not a coney. It was emphasized that even though beavers are untrained, they are wise enough to build their own home.

## **JESUS LINK:**

Jesus said, "Unless you become like a little child, you will not enter the kingdom of heaven."

## **TALK ABOUT IT:**

- In the Bible event what were the four animals and what wise things did they do?
- What big things can little children do for God?
- What big thing did Jesus do for us?
