This Week's Lesson:

Joshua Fights the Battle at Jericho –and God Wins

Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): God is awesome.

(Kids Say): Do what God says.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- Acted out Joshua fighting the battle of Jericho.
- Ate Bugles for snack, while reviewing the Bible event.
- Played the game, "Walls of Jericho," to review the Bible event and learn ways we can live God's way.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KIDS CHURCH.

- With a pantomime, we acted out the Battle of Jericho.
- Crushed cookies and put them on our pudding to remember God "crushed" the walls of Jericho.
- Made a horn out of newspaper.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Joshua Fights the Battle of Jericho and God wins, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Joshua 6:1-21.

JESUS LINK:

Jesus won the battle over our sin.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- How did God help the Israelites fight and win the battle of Jericho?
- What problems do we have that need God's help?
- How can we live life God's way? How does Jesus help us?

PRAYER POWER:

Ask God to help you with your battles. Ask God to help you live life his way. Thank Jesus for dying on the cross and winning the battle over sin.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Cut rocks out of gray construction paper and glue them onto a paper to make a picture of a wall. On each block, draw or write one way you can live life God's way. Hang it up as a reminder.
