## **FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse**

The Sun Stands Still, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Joshua 10:5-14.

## **JESUS LINK:**

Jesus did the hardest job of all when he died on the cross for our sins.

## **TALK ABOUT IT:**

- What problem did Joshua and the Israelite army face?
- How did God help them?
- What problems do you have? Why can you trust God to help you?

## **PRAYER POWER:**

Ask God to help you trust him with even your hardest problems.

## **FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:**

Lie on the grass and watch the sunset. Can you make the sun stay up in the sky? Of course not! But God made it stand still for Joshua. A God that is strong enough and powerful enough to make the sun stand still, is strong enough and powerful enough to help you with your problems.
