Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): I am God's child.

(Kids Say): I give my life to Jesus.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Watched a drama about Hannah and Samuel.
- Ate Life cereal and talked about ways we can give our lives to Jesus.
- Acted out the Bible event using a hula-hoop game.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Saw a video on Samuel's life.
- Made a "baby Samuel" with pretzels and cheese.
- Cleaned up the church to show caring for God's house.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Samuel is dedicated to the LORD, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from 1 Samuel 1.

JESUS LINK:

Jesus gave his life for us, and so we give our lives to him.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Why did Hannah give Samuel to God?
- Why do we give our lives to Jesus?
- How can we give our life to Jesus?

PRAYER POWER:

Thank Jesus for giving his life for you, and ask him to help you give your life to him.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Play "Bop the Balloon." Bop a balloon in the air. Each time someone bops it, they must say one way they can give their life to Jesus. (Examples: love him, pray to him, go to Kingdom Quest, obey his rules, help others, etc.) How many bops can you get in before the balloon falls to the ground?
