Foot Washing Fun

Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): Jesus served us.

(Kids Say): We Serve Others.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Heard the Bible event of how Jesus washed his disciples' feet.
- Made a craft tracing of our feet.
- Served each other in snack time.
- Played "Shoe scramble."

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Ate graham crackers dipped in blue milk to represent Jesus cleaning the disciples' feet.
- Made blue handprints on top of footprints.
- Watched Bubba in his "King Hat."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Jesus washes the Disciples' feet, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from John 13: 1-17. Ask child to act out Jesus' part.

JESUS LINK:

Jesus came to our world to serve us so we can serve others.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What did Jesus do to his disciples' feet to show he would serve them?
- What is the greatest way Jesus served us?
- What are some ideas you have to serve others?

PRAYER POWER:

Thank Jesus for serving and giving his life for us. Ask his help for ideas on how to serve others.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Surprise a member of the family by secretly taking their shoes and cleaning or shining them, then returning them to the closet. See if they notice that they've been served.
