This Week's Lesson:

Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): I am God's child.

(Kids Say): Little kids can do big things.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Acted out the story of David and Goliath.
- Made and ate edible stones.
- Played a target practice game, in which we learned to do big jobs.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Saw a video on David and Goliath.
- Made a paper Goliath and threw paper balls to pretend we're like David.
- Made a craft slingshot to remember, "little kids can do big things."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Small David beats big Goliath, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from 1 Samuel 17.

JESUS LINK:

Jesus gives me the power to do big things.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What big job did God give David?
- What big jobs does God give me?
- Who gives me the power to carry out those big jobs?

PRAYER POWER:

Ask God to help you with a specific job, such as learning to tie your shoes, or learning to make your bed.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Help your child do a big job for God's kingdom, such as picking out food to deliver to a food shelter, visiting an elderly person in the nursing home, or praying for someone who is ill. Stress to your child that little kids can make a big difference in God's kingdom.
