- Worked together on blocks and puzzles.

## **FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse**

The Good Samaritan, from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from Luke 10:25-37.

## **JESUS LINK:**

Jesus is our friend and wants to heal us.

## **TALK ABOUT IT:**

- How did the Good Samaritan show he was a good friend?
- How does Jesus show us he is our good friend?
- How can you be a good friend to others?

## **PRAYER POWER:**

Thank Jesus for being a good friend to you, and ask him to help you be a good friend to others.

## **FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:**

Help your child give the care package he or she made to a friend, especially an unchurched friend. Invite the friend to come to Kingdom Quest with your child.
