This Week's Lesson:

The Boy David is Anointed King

Take Home Point:

(Parents Say): I am God's child.

(Kids Say): God has big plans for me.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KINGDOM QUEST.

- Acted out the story of Samuel anointing the boy David king.
- Made a "Horn of Oil" snack.
- Played a game "Here's the Challenge" and talked about the plans God has for us.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN
KIDS CHURCH.

- Dipped Bugles in sauce to represent horns and oil.
- Heard the story about David's anointing on the felt board.
- Made hearts showing "God sees my heart."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

"The boy, David, is anointed king" from an early reading Bible, or read and summarize the event from 1 Samuel 16:1-13.

JESUS LINK:

With his Holy Spirit in our hearts, we can accomplish many things.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What big job did God have for the boy David?
- What big jobs does God give you?
- How does Jesus help you carry out God's plans for you?

PRAYER POWER:

Ask God to help you know the plans he has for you. Ask Jesus to send his Spirit to help you carry out those plans.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Let your children take turns being leader for the day. When a child is the leader, he or she gets to choose a favorite food for supper, pick out a favorite television show to watch, and sit in the favorite spot at the table, or while riding in the car. Being leader for the day is fun, but remember that being a leader in God's family means having important jobs from God. What jobs does God give you to do?
