Take Home Point:

God is powerful—God tames our fears.

DRIVE TIME HOME: PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY



- Puppet: Bubba thinks there are lions in the woods behind his home.
- Bible We watched a DVD about Daniel in the Lion's den.
- Craft: We made a lion tail to wear.
- Snack: We ate a pretend lion's head.
- Game: We played "Daniel, Daniel Lion!"
- We taught Albie the take home point.



- Participated in a drama telling the story of Daniel and the lions' den.
- Made and ate an edible "lion's face."
- Made lion's face puppets in the craft zone.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event from a children's' Bible:

Daniel and the lion's den: Daniel 6:1-28.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What happened in the story of Daniel and the lions' den?
- How did God show that he is powerful?
- How can God help us when we feel powerless?

PRAYER POWER:

(Have child repeat after adult)
