This Week's Lesson:

The Holy Spirit Comes at Pentecost

Take Home Point:

Jesus sent his Holy Spirit...The Holy Spirit lives in me.

DRIVE TIME HOME: PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY

- Bible Event: Participated in the Bible event and listen to a costumed character.

- When we receive Jesus' Spirit, how does he change us?
- How can we share God's Spirit with others?
