## This Week's Lesson:

Jesus Calms the Storm

## Take Home Point:

JESUS HELPS US....Give Jesus your fears.

### DRIVE TIME HOME: PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY



- Puppet: Bubba and Judy learn they can give their fears to Jesus.
- Bible We acted out Jesus calming the storm.
- Craft: We made a Stormy Seas Puppet.
- Snack: We ate crackers that sounded like rain.
- Game: We played "Pillow Relay Race."
- We taught Albie the take home point.



- The traveler dramatized the story of Jesus calming the storm.
- When we had a sugar cookie with blue frosting, our orange candy slice became a boat on the sea.
- Painted a storm that reminds us that Jesus will calm our fears and worries.

### FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Nighttime is often the most frightening time of the day for a child. Use fabric markers or paints and a white pillowcase to make a special reminder that Jesus helps us when we are afraid. Draw a circle and a triangle on the pillowcase to make the head and body of an angel. Trace your child's hands to make the wings. Write on the pillowcase, "Jesus' angels watch over me." Let your child decorate the pillowcase and when it has dried, put it on a pillow. Tell your child that when he or she is frightened the pillowcase can be a reminder that when they are afraid they can remember that Jesus loves them and sends his angels to watch over them and keep them safe.
