This Week's Lesson:

Jesus Heals a Blind Man

Take Home Point:

JESUS HELPS US....Give Jesus your hurts.

DRIVE TIME HOME: PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY



- Puppet: Bubba learns to give his hurts to Jesus.
- Bible Listened to storyteller share Bible event of Jesus healing a blind man.
- Craft: We made a Hurt Helping Cross.
- Snack: We made and ate pretend eyes.
- Game: We played Hot Potato.
- We taught Albie the take home point.



- Pretended we were blind.
- Felt our snacks in the "Mystery Bag" and tried to figure out what they were.
- The puppet presentation showed us Jesus cares for all our hurts.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event from a children's' Bible:

Jesus heals the blind man: Mark 8: 22-25

TALK ABOUT IT:

- How did Jesus help the blind man?
- What are some hurts you have had?
- What can you do when you get hurt?

PRAYER POWER:

(Have child repeat after adult)

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Help your child form a cross on an index card using two Band-Aids. Draw a "J" on the center of the cross. Tape the card to the outside of your medicine cabinet. Explain to your child that the card is a reminder to ask Jesus for help when someone gets hurt.
