This Week's Lesson:

Jesus Heals Daughter of Jairus

Take Home Point:

Jesus Helps us...Give Jesus your worries.

DRIVE TIME HOME: PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY



- Puppet: Bubba is worried about his puppy.
- Bible We acted out Jairus being worried about his daughter and Jesus healing her.
- Craft: We made a Happy Heart/Worried Face neck ware
- Snack: We pretended our snack was Jarius' daughter being helped by Jesus.
- Game: We played 'Don't Worry Balloon Smack'.
- We taught Albie the take home point.



- Listened and watched a video about the story of Jairus' daughter.
- With our snack we pretended to wrap Jairus' daughter in a blanket.
- We made "Hope Cards" to give to others.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event from a children's' Bible:

Jesus Heals Jairus' Daughter: Mark 5:21-24, 35-43

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What was Jairus worried about and did Jesus help him?
- What do you worry about?
- How can you give your worries to Jesus?

PRAYER POWER:

(Have child repeat after adult)

Thank you, thank you, thank you.
In Jesus' name. Amen.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Stuff a bag with newspapers. As the bag grows bigger, explain the same thing happens to our worries when we keep them to ourselves. They just grow bigger. When the bag is full, tape it closed. Take turns tossing the bag back and forth. As you toss the bag, Mom or Dad says, "Jesus helps us." The child responds, "Give Jesus your worries." When finished, explain that when we give Jesus our worries, he helps us with them and they don't have to grow bigger.
