Take Home Point:

Jesus is our friend...Jesus loves me.

DRIVE TIME HOME: PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY



- Puppet: Bubba thinks no big people want him around.
- Bible Event: We helped act out children gathering around Jesus.
- Craft: We made a Jesus Message Pouch.
- Snack: We ate foods that explained the Bible Event.
- Game: We played Jesus' Blessings.
- We taught Albie the take home point.



- Tried to get near the presenter by playing, "Red Light, Green Light."
- Learned that Jesus wants the little children to come near to him.
- Made a heart-shaped craft to show us that "Jesus touches us with his love."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event from a children's' Bible:

Jesus Blesses the Children (Matthew 19: 13-15)

TALK ABOUT IT:

- How do you feel if some tells you, "Go away"?
- How do you think the children in the story felt?
- How did Jesus show the children he loves them?
- How does Jesus show you that he loves you?

PRAYER POWER:

(Have child repeat after adult)

He is our friend.

Thank you, thank you, thank you.
In Jesus' name. Amen.
