## This Week's Lesson:

Jesus Call His First Disciples

## Take Home Point:

Jesus is Our Friend...We follow Jesus.

### DRIVE TIME HOME: PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY



- Puppet: Bubba learned that Jesus wanted people to follow him.
- Bible Event: We participated in acting out Jesus calling his disciples.
- Craft: We made stick figures to walk on the Jesus path.
- Snack: We ate boats and fish.

- How can we follow Jesus?
