Take Home Point:

Jesus gave himself for me...I remember Jesus.

DRIVE TIME HOME: PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY



- Puppet: Bubba learned that Jesus had a remember meal.
- Bible Event: We participated in acting out The Last Supper.
- Craft: We made Remember Books.
- Snack: We ate food like Jesus and the disciples.
- Game: We played Remember Action.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What do the bread and the wine from the Lord's Supper make us remember?
- Why did Jesus die for us?
