This Week's Lesson:

Jesus Goes Home with Zacchaeus

Take Home Point:

Jesus is our friend...We will bring Jesus home.

DRIVE TIME HOME: PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY



- Puppet: Bubba was told he was too little to play with some neighbors.
- Bible Event: We heard from a costumed character laying Zacchaeus.
- Craft: We made a Zacchaeus book.
- Snack: We made a snack for a friend.
- Game: We played Balloon Bop Relay.

- Watched a video about Zacchaeus climbing a tree to see Jesus.
- Made a house of graham crackers and frosting.
- Played with the dollhouse and pretended to take Jesus home.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event from a children's' Bible:

Jesus Goes Home With Zacchaeus (Luke 19:1-10.)

TALK ABOUT IT:

- How did Jesus show Zacchaeus he was his friend?
- How does Jesus show us he is our friend?
- How can we bring Jesus home with us?

PRAYER POWER:

(Have child repeat after adult)

Dear God,
We love you.
Jesus is our friend.
We will bring Jesus home.
Thank you, thank you, thank you.
In Jesus' name.
Amen.
