This Week's Lesson:

Take Home Point:

Jesus helps us...We thank Jesus.

DRIVE TIME HOME: PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY



- Puppet: Judy was reminded to say thank you.
- Bible Event: We participated in acting out Jesus healing the ten lepers.
- Craft: We made a Thank You Jesus card.
- Snack: We made and ate Thankful Lips.
- Game: We played Have a Ball Giving Thanks.
- We taught Albie the take home point.



- The dramatized leper told us how Jesus healed him.
- Learned to say "Thank you" for our blessings.
- Our raisins and grapes gave us a picture of how many were lepers were unthankful and how many thanked Jesus for healing them.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event from a children's' Bible:

TALK ABOUT IT:

- How did Jesus help the ten lepers?
- How does Jesus help us?
- One leper came back and thanked Jesus for helping him. When Jesus helps us, what can we do?
