TALK ABOUT IT:

- What happened when Adam and Eve sinned?
- How do you sin?
- Why, when you sin, can you be forgiven?

PRAYER POWER:

(Have child repeat after adult)

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS:

Put a piece of candy in front of your child and before leaving the room, tell child not to eat it. Return in 30 seconds. If the child does not eat the candy, praise child and remind him how Eve was not able to resist doing what was wrong.
