Take Home Point:

I am God's Child...Little kids can do big things.

DRIVE TIME HOME: PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY



- Puppet: Judy learned that little kids can do big things.
- Bible Event: We participated in acting out David and King Saul.
- Craft: We made a Shepherd's Pouch and filled it with big jobs "stones".

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event from a children's' Bible:

David and Goliath (1 Samuel 17)

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What big job did God give David?
- What big jobs does God give me?
- Who gives me the power to carry out those big jobs?

PRAYER POWER:

(Have child repeat after adult)

I am your child.
I can do big things.
Thank you, thank you, thank you.
In Jesus' name.
Amen.
