Take Home Point:

DRIVE TIME HOME: PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY



- Puppet: Bubba learned that the smallest person can have a big job.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What big job did God have for the boy David?
- What big jobs does God give you?
- How does Jesus help you carry out God's plans for you?

PRAYER POWER:

(Have child repeat after adult)
