Take Home Point:

GOD IS AWESOME...God shows me his power.

DRIVE TIME HOME: PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY

Elijah is taken to heaven in a fiery chariot. (2 Kings 2:1-18)

TALK ABOUT IT:

- How did God show his power through Elijah and Elisha?
- How does God show me his power?
- What was the best thing Jesus did to show us his power?

PRAYER POWER:

(Have child repeat after adult)
