Zacchaeus Shares His Wealth

Take Home Point:

Jesus helps us share.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Judy learns that God wants us to share.
- *Bible:* We read about Zacchaeus from a picture Bible and acted it out.
- *Snack:* We ate a snack that looked like coins.
- *Craft:* We made coins on our craft showing Zacchaeus sharing his money with others.
- *Game:* We played a game called *Share or Not Sharing*
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Mary Had a Little Lamb*: "Jesus helps us all to share, all to share, all to share. Jesus helps us all to share to share with everyone."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. Luke 19:1-10

LEARN BY DOING:

Sharing is a difficult concept for a young child. They think that what ever they have (or want) is theirs and they usually do not like to share. Make sure you praise your child when he/she willingly shares something. Verbalizing helps to reinforce the action.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Jesus loves us and knows we can change like Zacchaeus did.
- Jesus wants to be our friend.
- Jesus wants us to share.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult

Dear God,

We love you.

Thank you for Jesus.

Help us to share.

Thank you, thank you, thank you.

In Jesus' name.

Amen.
