## DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- Puppet: Judy sings to lift the presenter's mood.
- *Bible*: We heard how boy David played his harp for the king.
- *Snack*: We ate a snack that looked like a harp.
- *Craft*: We made a harp.
- *Game*: We played musical instruments.
- *Singing*: To the tune of *Row, Row, Row Your Boat*: "Praise, praise, praise our God. Praise him every day. Praise, praise, praise our God. Praise him every day."

### FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. 1 Samuel 16:14-23

### LEARN BY DOING:

Children can be encouraged to sing. No matter how your voice sounds, their simple noises can be personal expressions of praise to God. Encourage your child to listen to simple children's praise music and join along. They can even pretend to play an instrument as they sing along.

### TALK ABOUT IT:

- What ways do we praise God in church?
- What ways do we praise God at home?
- God wants us to praise him in a joyful way through music, singing and prayer.

**ECHO PRAYER:** Child repeats each line after adult
