Take Home Point:

We listen to God.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Bubba learns that it is very important to listen.
- *Bible:* We heard how God talked to Samuel.
- *Snack:* We ate a snack that people listen to.
- *Craft:* We made a silly face with listening ears.
- *Game:* We played a game called *Listening Ears*.
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Farmer in the Dell*: "Listen now to God. Listen now to God. He wants to talk to us. Listen now to God."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. Samuel 3:1-21

LEARN BY DOING:

Set aside a special time and place to read the picture Bible with your child. This may be the last thing before bed or after supper. Remind your child that that when he/she listens to the Bible, he/she is listening to God.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- God talks to us in his word and we can listen.
- God talked to Samuel at nighttime and Samuel listened.
- We need to listen to God.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult
