Daniel Keeps Praying

Take Home Point:

Obey God.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Judy learns that being obedient makes everyone happy.
- *Bible:* We heard how Daniel kept on praying to God, even though the king ordered him not to.
- *Snack:* We ate a snack that looked like lion's claws.
- *Craft:* We painted praying hands.
- *Game:* We played a game called *Are We Obeying?*
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Mary Had a Little Lamb*: "We can learn to obey God, obey God, obey God. We can learn to obey God. Obey him every day."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. Daniel 6:3-16

LEARN BY DOING:

We need to teach our children to obey God even though it might not be convenient or popular. Daniel knew there would be serious consequences if he disobeyed a new law to pray to the king only. He chose to obey God, not man. Be a good example and let your children see you praying.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Daniel prayed even when the king told him not to.
- God wants us to obey him.
- God will take care of us.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult

Dear God,

We love you.

Help us obey you.

Thank you, thank you, thank you.

In Jesus' name.

Amen.
