## DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Bubba learns that God watches over us.
- *Bible:* We read about baby Moses floating down the river in a basket.
- *Snack:* We ate a snack that reminded us of a basket.
- *Craft:* We made a baby Moses in a basket.
- *Game:* We played a water game called *Float or Sink?*
- *Singing:* To the tune of: *Farmer in the Dell*: "God watches over us. God watches over us. He will take good care of us. God watches over us."

## FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. Exodus 2:1-10

## LEARN BY DOING:

As other people take care of your two-year-old, talk about how God watches over us. He cares for us. For example, when watching others out your window at home or when you are at the park or driving in your car, look for caregivers of others and relate it to how God watches over us.

## TALK ABOUT IT:

- Moses' mother trusted God.
- Moses was rescued by Pharaoh's daughter.
- God will watch over us.

**ECHO PRAYER:** Child repeats each line after adult

Thank you, thank you, thank you.

In Jesus' name.
