Take Home Point:

Praise God for Jesus.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Bubba gets a gift from his grandma... and God.
- *Bible:* We acted out and read a Big Book about angels telling the shepherds about Baby Jesus.
- *Snack:* We ate a snack that looked like angels.
- *Craft:* We made an angel like the one in our Bible Event.
- *Game:* We played a game called *Send the Shepherd to the Manger*.
- *Singing:* To the tune of: *Row, Row, Row Your Boat*. "Jesus is the gift, He's the Son of God. Praise him, praise him, praise him, praise him. He's the Son of God."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. Luke 2:8-20

LEARN BY DOING:

As you travel around your city this Christmas season, point out angel and shepherd figures. When you point them out, retell the Christmas story, what the angels said, and what the shepherds did. Have your kids respond, "Praise God for Jesus."

TALK ABOUT IT:

- The angels appeared to the shepherds to tell them of Jesus' birth.
- The shepherds told everyone what they had seen.
- Praise God for sending his Son Jesus.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult says it.

Dear God,

We love you.

You gave us your Son Jesus.

Thank you, thank you, thank you.

In Jesus' name.

Amen.
