Take Home Point:

Jesus is alive!

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Judy is sad, then happy when she learns Jesus is alive.
- *Bible:* We read from the Bible that Jesus is alive!
- *Snack:* We ate crackers that looked like a butterfly.
- *Craft:* We made a butterfly craft.
- *Game:* We played a game called *Catch the Rock*.
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Farmer in the Dell*: "Jesus is alive. Jesus is alive. He came to save us all, Jesus is alive."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. Luke 24:1-12

LEARN BY DOING:

Talk about how butterflies remind us of new life coming from the cocoon. Notice other spring signs of life in nature. Talk about how Jesus is alive, even if we can't see him.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Jesus died on the cross, but on the third day became alive again!
- Jesus' friends found the tomb empty and their sadness turned to joy.
- Even though we cannot see Jesus, he is alive!

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult says it.

Dear God,

We love you.

You gave us Jesus.

Jesus died.

Now he's alive.

Thank you, thank you, thank you.

In Jesus' name.

Amen.
