Take Home Point:

I can serve God.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- Puppet: Judy learned that even though she is little, she can serve God.
- Bible: We learned about and acted out how David took care of the sheep.
- Snack: We ate food that reminded us of sheep.
- Craft: We made sheep ear headbands so we can remember David.
- Game: We played a learning game called *Am I Serving God?* and a movement game called *Follow the Sheep*.
- Singing: To the tune of *Frère Jacques*: I can serve God. I can serve God. You can, too. You can, too. You and I can serve God. You and I can serve God. We serve God. We serve God.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read about God choosing David from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. (1 Samuel 16:10-13 & Psalm 23)

LEARN BY DOING:

Remind your child that as they serve others in the family, that is another way of serving God. Point out helpful activities for them such as, picking up toys, setting the table, and being kind to others.

POINTS TO REMEMBER:

- David served God by being a shepherd and later a king.
- God chooses us to serve him, no matter how small we are.
- We can serve God by praying.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult

Dear God,

You are with us.

We love you.

Help me serve you.

Thank you, thank you, thank you.

In Jesus' name.
