Take Home Point:

Worship God

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- Puppet: Judy learns about God's temple.
- Bible: We learned about and acted out Solomon building the temple in seven days.
- Snack: We ate a healthy snack because our body is like God's temple.
- Craft: We made a golden table like one in the temple.
- Game: We played a learning game called *God's Temple* and a movement game called *Taking Care of God's Temple*.
- Singing: To the tune of *Frère Jacques*: Worship God. Worship God. Every day. Every day. God wants us to worship. God wants us to worship. Only him. Only him.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read about Solomon building an elegant temple for God from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. (1 Kings 6)

LEARN BY DOING:

Remind your child of activities that take care of our bodies, such as eating properly, exercise, washing our hands and plenty of sleep. Refer to our body as God's temple, because he lives in us as we love him.

POINTS TO REMEMBER:

- A temple reminds us that God is with us.
- A temple is a place to worship God.
- David's son, King Solomon, built a temple for God.
- Our body is like God's temple because he lives in us.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult
