Take Home Point:

Jesus says, "Follow me."

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- Puppet: Judy learns how to follow Jesus.
- Bible: We learned about and acted out how Jesus chose Matthew to be a disciple.
- Snack: We ate coin cookies.
- Craft: We made finger puppets that can follow Jesus.
- Game: We played a learning game called *Follow Me* and a movement game of *Follow the Leader*.
- Singing: To the tune of: *Mary Had a Little Lamb*. Jesus said come follow me. Follow me. Follow me. Jesus said come follow me. Please follow me right now.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read about Jesus choosing Matthew to be a disciple from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. (Luke 5:27-31)

LEARN BY DOING:

Play "Follow the Leader" as you show your child how to do simple tasks of serving. (ex., clear the table, pickup toys, etc.)

POINTS TO REMEMBER:

- Matthew dropped everything and followed Jesus.
- Matthew learned that Jesus was more important than money.
- Everyone should follow Jesus.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult.
