Take Home Point:

I am important to God.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- Puppet: Bubba loses his offering.
- Bible: We learned about and acted out how a woman lost a coin and then found it.
- Snack: We ate a snack that reminded us of a coin.
- Craft: We hid coins on a picture we colored.
- Game: We played a learning game called *Need a Coin?* and a movement game called *I am Important*.
- Singing: To the tune of: *Mary Had a Little Lamb*. I am important to God. Yes I am, Yes I am. I am important to God. He loves me all the time.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read about the parable of the lost coin from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. (Luke 15:8-10)

LEARN BY DOING:

Before picking up toys, hide a favorite toy. Play a game of looking for the favorite toy and have a celebration when you find it. Explain that God is happy when he finds people who are lost and don't know that he loves them.

POINTS TO REMEMBER:

- Jesus told a parable about a woman losing a coin.
- Everyone is important to God.
- God is happy when we believe.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult.
