Take Home Point:

I am important to God.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- Puppet: Judy learns she is important to God.
- Bible: We learned about and acted out how one sheep was lost and then found.
- Snack: We ate a snack that looked like a sheep.
- Craft: We made a sheep.
- Game: We played a learning game called *Lost or Found?* and a movement game called *Follow the Sheep*.
- Singing: To the tune of: *Mary Had a Little Lamb*. I am important to God. Yes I am, Yes I am. I am important to God. He loves me all the time.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read about the parable Jesus told of leaving the 99 sheep to find the one lost from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. (Luke 15:1-7)

LEARN BY DOING:

Play a game with your child by hiding a favorite toy and then search for it. When finding it, talk about how God is happy, too, when he finds someone who is lost or alone.

POINTS TO REMEMBER:

- Every person is important to God.
- God wants us to be in his family.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult.

That I am important to you.
