DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- Puppet: Bubba learns about a king being born in a barn.
- Bible: We learned about and acted out how Jesus was born in a barn.
- Snack: We ate animal crackers.
- Craft: We made a Baby Jesus stick puppet.
- Game: We played a learning game called *What Animal Am I?* and a movement game called *Barnyard Scramble*.
- Singing: To the tune of: *Fréré Jaques*. God sends Jesus. God sends Jesus. Yes he does. Yes he does. God said he would send him. God said he would send him. God loves us. God loves us.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read about Jesus' birth from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. (Luke 2: 1-20)

LEARN BY DOING:

When you put out your Christmas decorations and the nativity set, involve your child. Tell the story and have them make some of the sounds that go with Baby Jesus being born in a barn. It was a surprising place for God's Son to be born.

POINTS TO REMEMBER:

- Jesus is God's Son.
- Jesus was born in a barn but is still a king.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult.
