DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- Puppet: Judy learned about baptism.
- Bible: We learned about and acted out John the Baptist baptizing Jesus.
- Snack: We ate pretzels that made us thirsty for water.
- Craft: We made a dove like the one that came down from heaven when Jesus was baptized.
- Game: We played a learning game called *Do We Use Water For This?* and a movement game called *God's Child...Go!*
- Singing: To the tune of: *Farmer in the Dell*. Jesus is God's Son. Jesus is God's Son. He came to save us all. Jesus is God's Son.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read about Jesus' baptism from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. (Matthew 3)

LEARN BY DOING:

When giving your child a bath, talk about how Jesus was baptized. God said, "This is my Son. I am happy with him." Explain to your child that God washed away our sins because of what Jesus has done. Because of that, we can be children of God as well.

POINTS TO REMEMBER:

- John was sent to prepare the people for Jesus.
- John baptized Jesus with water.
- Jesus is God's Son.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult.

We love you.
Jesus is your Son.
Thank you, thank you, thank you.
In Jesus' name.
