## DRIVE TIME HOME

### PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Judy learns that Jesus rose from the dead and is alive.
- *Bible:* We learned about and acted out the three women finding Jesus' tomb empty.
- *Snack:* We ate a snack that looked like the rock that was rolled away from the tomb.
- *Craft:* We made a picture with a rock that can roll away from the tomb.
- *Game:* We played a game called, *Alive or Not Alive?*
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Farmer in the Dell*. "Jesus is alive. Jesus is alive. He is risen from the grave. Jesus is alive."

### FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read about the empty tomb from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. (Luke 24:1-12)

### LEARN BY DOING:

Put a piece of candy in a plastic Easter egg. Talk about the joy of opening the egg and discovering the treat. When the ladies went to the tomb, they found the tomb open and their treat was much more wonderful than candy. It was the fact that Jesus was raised after he died on the cross.

### POINTS TO REMEMBER:

- Jesus died, then rose from the dead.
- Jesus is alive!

### ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult
