Jesus and the Lost Son

Take Home Point:

I am important to God.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- Puppet: Judy learns that everyone is important to God.
- Bible: We learned about and acted out the lost son leaving home and returning to his happy father.
- Snack: We ate a traveling snack.
- Craft: We made stick puppets of the lost son and his father and a map to guide him.
- Game: We played a learning game called *Leaving or Coming Back?* and a movement game called *Coming and Going*.
- Singing: To the tune of: *Mary Had a Little Lamb*. I am important to God. Yes I am, Yes I am. I am important to God. He loves me all the time.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read about the lost son from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. (Luke 15:11-27)

LEARN BY DOING:

Look for an opportunity when your child is missing you. Go to your child and remind them how you love them. Tell them how you like to "find" them when they feel lost. This is similar to how God loves you.

POINTS TO REMEMBER:

- A father was happy when his lost son returned home.
- We are God's children.
- We are important to God.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult.

We love you.
We are important to you.
Thank you, thank you, thank you.
In Jesus' name.
Amen.
