This Week's Lesson:

Jesus Died on the Cross

Take Home Point:

Jesus died for us.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Bubba learns about the cross.
- *Bible:* We learned about and acted out the events leading up to Jesus' death on the cross.
- *Snack:* We ate a cross snack.
- *Craft:* We made a cross neck decoration.
- *Game:* We played a game called *Alive or Not Alive?* and one called *Rock on a Roll*.
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Mary Had a Little Lamb*. "Jesus died for our sins. For our sins, for our sins. Jesus died for our sins. But now he is alive!"

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read about Jesus' death on the cross from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. (Matthew 27:11-56)

LEARN BY DOING:

Young children do not really understand the concept of death. Focus on Jesus rising from the dead when explaining this event.

POINTS TO REMEMBER:

- People did not believe Jesus was God's Son so they put him to death.
- Jesus knew it was time for his death and was ready.
- Jesus triumphed over all by rising from the dead three days later.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult.

Dear God,
You are with us.
We love you.
Your Son Jesus died for us.
Thank you, thank you, thank you.
In Jesus' name.
Amen.
