This Week's Kingdom Quest Lesson:

Good King Hezekiah

Take Home Point:

Who's on your side? We're on God's side!

Drive Time Home

Tickler Question: What did King Hezekiah do to show that he was on God's side? *(Cleaned out the temple, trusted God to defeat the Assyrian army.)*

God Time at Home

Select questions and adapt for your family.

FOR STARTERS: Invite every family member to talk about a team that they were once chosen to be on. This could be a sports team, a team on a playground, a team to do a special task or job, even a family team. Discuss how you feel when you think about God choosing you to be a part of his team?

READ THE BIBLE: Read from a Bible storybook about Hezekiah. 2 Chronicles 29:1-31 or read 2 Chronicles 29:3-6, 35-36, 32:20-22

KEY VERSE: Joshua 24:15, "...choose today whom you will serve...my family and I will still serve the Lord."

TALK ABOUT IT: Prior to King Hezekiah's rule, what had the kings of Israel allowed to happen to the temple? *(It wasn't used for the worship of God and fell into disrepair.)* What did Hezekiah do to solve that problem? *(He had the priests repair and begin worship practices to help everyone serve and worship God.)* The king of Assyria, King Sennacherib, came to Jerusalem to attack King Hezekiah and the people. He had destroyed many other nations and thought he couldn't be beaten. He thought his vast army would easily overpower Jerusalem. What did Hezekiah do? *(He prayed and trusted God to deliver them.)* What did God do? *(God sent his angels and wiped out the enemy.)*

God chooses you to follow him. What do you think will happen if you are following him and others come against you? *(God gives the victory to everyone that follows him.)* Remember that Jesus gave his life for us so that we would always have victory, even over sin and death.

PRAYER POWER: Thank God that he has chosen us and given his Son Jesus. Thank God that he gives us victory as we face battles. Ask him to help remind us that we are on his side.

FAMILY TIME OPTIONS: Since the Lord has chosen you, how might you as a family serve him? Think of one project this week that you could do as a family to help one other person and show that you are on God's side.
