Take Home Point:

Jesus sent his Spirit...God's Holy Spirit Lives In Me

DRIVE TIME HOME: PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY



- Puppet: It's Bubba's birthday and he learns that all fire does not burn.
- Bible Event: We imagined what it was like to be in the room when the Holy Spirit came.
- Craft: We made a Tongue of Fire Crown
- Snack: We made fire sticks and ate them.
- Game: We used our wind power to move a cotton ball.
- We taught Albie the take home point.



- We used a hair dryer and ping pong ball to illustrate the unseen Holy Spirit.
- We made a windsock to remind us of the Holy Spirit.

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event from a children's' Bible:

The Holy Spirit comes at Pentecost, the birthday of the Church (Acts 12:1-14, 38-41)

TALK ABOUT IT:

- What happened to Jesus' followers when the Holy Spirit came?
- When is the birthday of the Christian church?
- Jesus promised to give us his Holy Spirit. How does that change us?
