Take Home Point:
Jesus wants to be our friend.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Bubba learns that Jesus wants to be his special friend.
- *Bible:* We read a big book about Zacchaeus and acted it out.
- *Snack:* We ate a snack that looked like coins.
- *Craft:* We decorated flowers and made one to give one to a friend.
- *Game:* We played a game called *Toss the Coins*.
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Mary Had a Little Lamb*: "Jesus wants to be our friend, be our friend, be our friend. Jesus wants to be our friend, short, tall or small."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. Luke 19:1-10

LEARN BY DOING:

Friends are real treasures. Tell your child about friends you had when you were small. Tell them that good friends treat each other kindly, share their toys and pray for each other. Jesus wants to be our friend and wants us to share our thoughts.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Jesus loves us and wants to be our friend.
- Jesus loves everyone, even people no one else loves.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult

Dear God,

We are so happy.
Jesus wants to be our friend.
Thank you, thank you, thank you.
In Jesus' name.
