Take Home Point:

Jesus is alive!

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Judy hears the Good News.
- *Bible:* We acted out the Bible Event of Jesus' resurrection.
- *Snack:* We ate pretend rocks.
- *Craft:* We made a rolling rock craft.
- *Game:* We played the "Roll the Rock" game.
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Farmer in the Dell*: "Jesus is alive. Jesus is alive. He came to save us all. Jesus is alive."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Let your child see that you are reading from the Bible as you paraphrase down to a few simple sentences. Matthew 28:1-10

LEARN BY DOING:

Make a point of sharing good news with your child. It can be as simple as "The sun is shining today." Remind child that the Good News from the Bible is: ***Jesus is alive!**

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Jesus died then became alive.
- Jesus is with us always, even if we can't see him.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult

Dear God,
We love you.
Thank you for Jesus.
He died for us.
Now he is alive!
Thank you, thank you, thank you.
In Jesus' name.
Amen.
