Take Home Point:

Listen to God's word.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Judy learns to listen to God's word.
- *Bible:* We heard how God sent a hand to write on the wall to warn King Belshazzar.
- *Snack:* We ate letter cookies.
- *Craft:* We put letters on our paper.
- *Game:* We wrote in the sand.
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Farmer in the Dell*: "Listen to God's word. Listen to God's word. Listen, listen, listen, listen. Listen to God's word."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. Daniel 5

LEARN BY DOING:

The Bible is God's word. Everything in the Bible is true and it tells us all we need to know. Children love to be read to and regular habits of reading to your two-year-old from the Bible helps him/her learn to love God's word. Compliment your child when he/she chooses the Bible storybook for reading and listens well. Reinforce the point: **Listen to God's Word.*

TALK ABOUT IT:

- God wrote words on the wall.
- We need to listen to what God says to us.
- God talks to us in the Bible.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult

Dear God,

We love you.

Help us listen.

Thank you, thank you, thank you.
