This Week's Lesson:

Hannah Prays for a Baby

Take Home Point:

God hears our prayers.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Judy learns that God hears our prayers.
- *Bible:* We heard how Hannah prayed to God for a baby. God heard her prayers and gave her Samuel.
- *Snack:* We ate a crunchy snack that our ears could hear.
- *Craft:* We made ear decorations to remind us that God's ears hear our prayers.
- *Game:* We played a game called *Listening Ears*.
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Frère Jacques*: "Pray to God. Pray to God. God hears prayer. God hears prayer. He will listen to us. He will listen to us. Pray to God. Pray to God."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. 1 Samuel 1 & 2

LEARN BY DOING:

Prayer is such a powerful tool. It is necessary that you help your child with his/her nightly prayers. Your child also needs to see you praying. A young child wants to imitate parents. Practice folding your hands and praying with your child at meal times, nighttime and any special time of prayer. Your child will repeat the prayer words after you. Tell your child about a time when God answered your prayers.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Prayer is talking to God.
- Hannah believed God would answer her prayers for a son—and he did.
- God hears their prayers.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult

Dear God,
We love you.
You hear our prayers.
Thank you, thank you, thank you.
In Jesus' name.
Amen.
