Jesus Heals the Blind Men

Take Home Point:

Jesus helps us.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Bubba is blinded by his baseball cap.
- *Bible:* We help act out the Bible Event about the two blind men that Jesus cured.
- *Snack:* We ate cookies decorated like eyes.
- *Craft:* We made a visor to protect our eyes.
- *Game:* We played *Eye Spy*.
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Mary Had a Little Lamb*: "Here's two men who could not see, could not see, could not see. Here's two men who could not see, so Jesus gave them sight."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. Matthew 20:29-34

LEARN BY DOING:

Help your child appreciate his/her eyes. Explain that not all eyes are perfect. Some people need glasses or contacts to help them see. Play the *Eye Spy* game (choose an item in the room and child tries to guess what it is). When child finds the object, say, "Thank you, God, for my eyes."

TALK ABOUT IT:

- The blind men knew Jesus would help them.
- Jesus cured the blind men.
- Jesus will help us.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult says it.

Dear God,
We love you.
You gave us Jesus.
Jesus helps us.
Thank you, thank you, thank you.
In Jesus' name.
Amen.
