Take Home Point:

Praise Jesus, the King.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Judy learns that Jesus is a King.
- *Bible:* We acted out a Palm Sunday parade.
- *Snack:* We ate a sparkly snack.
- *Craft:* We made a crown with sparkly jewels.
- *Game:* We played *Hide the Jewel*.
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Row, Row, Row Your Boat*: "Praise, praise, praise our King, Jesus is our King. Praise, praise, praise our king, Jesus is our King."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Let your child see that you are reading from the Bible as you paraphrase down to a few simple sentences. Matthew 21:1-11

LEARN BY DOING:

Small children think of kings as powerful men who wear crowns and fancy robes. Remind them that Jesus is a special king who doesn't need fancy clothes, crowns and jewels. He is a humble king who loves us and is with us all the time.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- We can praise Jesus.
- Jesus is our King.
- Jesus loves us.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult says it.

Dear God,

We love you.

Thank you for Jesus.

We praise Jesus the King.

Thank you, thank you, thank you.

In Jesus' name.
