Jesus Prays in the Garden

Take Home Point:

Pray to God day and night.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Judy learns to pray day and night.
- *Bible:* Jesus prays in the garden.
- *Snack:* We ate a day and night cookie.
- *Craft:* We made a day and night picture.
- *Game:* We played a game called *Day or Night?*.
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Row, Row, Row your Boat*: "Pray, pray, pray to God, pray each day and night. Pray, pray, pray to God, pray each day and night."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Let your child see that you are reading from the Bible as you paraphrase down to a few simple sentences: Luke 22: 39-44

LEARN BY DOING:

Children need to be reminded that we can pray to God anytime, day or night. Demonstrate this by saying short prayers with your child during various times of the day.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Jesus prayed to God his Father.
- Jesus wants us to pray.
- We can pray anytime, anywhere.

ECHO PRAYER Child repeats each line after adult says it.

Dear God,
We love you.
Help us to pray,
Each day and night.
Thank you, thank you, thank you.
In Jesus' name.
Amen.
