Take Home Point:

Jesus helps us.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Judy learns that Jesus calmed a storm.
- *Bible:* We acted out Jesus calming the storm.
- *Snack:* We ate a snack that reminded us of boats.
- *Craft:* We made wind sticks.
- *Game:* We played an active game called *Jesus Helps Us*.
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Farmer in the Dell*: "Jesus calmed the storm. Jesus calmed the storm. Jesus helps us all the time. Jesus calmed the storm."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. Matthew 8:23-27

LEARN BY DOING:

Next time there is a storm, remind your child that even Jesus' disciples or followers were afraid in a storm. They asked Jesus to help them and he did. Remember to ask Jesus for help.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Jesus has the power to calm the storm. Jesus is God.
- Jesus helps the disciples who thought they would drown.
- Jesus helps us when we are scared.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult says it.

You help us and love us.
Thank you, thank you, thank you.
