Jesus Helps Men See

Take Home Point:

Jesus helps us.

DRIVE TIME HOME

PARENTS, ASK ME WHAT I DID TODAY IN KINGDOM QUEST.

- *Puppet:* Judy learns what it's like to blind and hears how Jesus helped the blind men.
- *Bible:* We heard and acted out how Jesus helped two blind men see.
- *Snack:* We ate a snack that reminds us of eyes—grapes.
- *Craft:* We made two stick people with big eyes, one to keep and one for a friend.
- *Game:* We played a game called *Toss the Eyes*.
- *Singing:* To the tune of *Mary Had a Little Lamb*: "Here's two men who could not see, could not see, could not see. Here's two men who could not see, but Jesus gave them sight."

FAMILY DEVOTIONS: Read the Bible Event or Bible Verse

Read from a children's picture Bible or paraphrase from an adult Bible so your child will understand. Matthew 20:29-34

LEARN BY DOING:

Jesus hears our prayers. He wants us to ask him for help and he loves us enough to answer our prayers with "Yes," "No," and "Wait." Talk to your child about answered prayer in your life. Help your child learn to pray by repeating simple phrases of a prayer.

TALK ABOUT IT:

- Jesus helps us when we ask.
- We can talk to Jesus about anything.
- Jesus loves us enough to help us.

ECHO PRAYER: Child repeats each line after adult says it.

Dear God,

We love you.

You will help us

When we ask.

Thank you, thank you, thank you.

In Jesus' name.
